For a 3" high tree, you will need one piece of yarn/string 8" long folded in half and knotted near the top leaving a loop at the end and then 16 other pieces about 3" long. (I just wrapped these around my 4 fingers and cut them at the ends)





Double-fold macrame yarn and leave a loop for hanging, tie a knot below the loop.
These two threads form the middle of the fir.



Place macrame twine in two and under the two threads from step 1.



Double-fold a second macrame yarn and place under the threads from step 1. Pass both threads over the middle threads into the loop from step 1.



Pull the loop tight.



Knot a total of 8 rows.



Cut the threads into shape with scissors.
Use a comb to separate /fray threads if you like.
You may want to trim it again after that.
